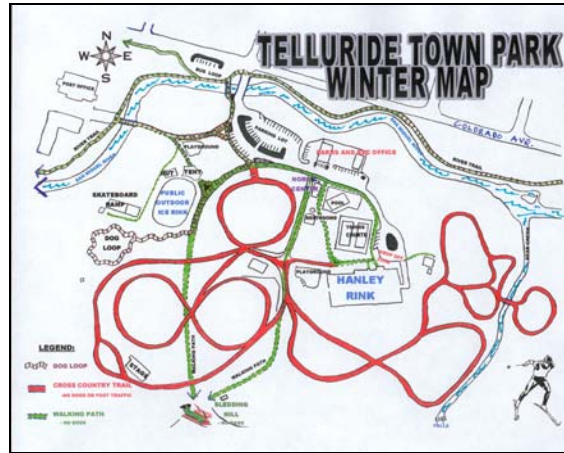

Cross County Trails



The Cross Country trails in Town Park are maintained throughout the winter and are groomed for both skate skiing and track skiing. Approximately 2.5 kilometers of track wind through Town Park and are suited for beginning and intermediate level skiers. **A special loop is available for dogs along the western edge of the park.** Dogs are not allowed on XC trails

Sledding Hill



Our sledding hill provides hours of free fun for the whole family. It is located near the stage on the southern hillside of Town Park. Please use the footpath, marked with orange cones and signs, to access the hill. Plan to bring your own sleds or rent from the Nordic Center.

Ice Rink Information



The Hanley Rink and the Outdoor Ice Rink, both located in Town Park, are maintained daily. The Hanley Rink includes a covered NHL-sized sheet of ice, restrooms, lobby and dressing rooms. Please check our Hanley Rink schedule for Public Skating, Stick Handling, Ice Hockey Program and Broomball League details.

The Hanley Rink opens October 29th, 2007 & closes March 16th, 2008.
